CIP PROJECT NO. C14-08 PACHECO BLVD. & SHELL OIL EASEMENT SEWER REHABILITATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that for and behalf of the District Board, the District Manager of the Mt. View Sanitary District, Contra Costa County, California, will receive up to, but not later than 2:00 PM on August 27, 2008 sealed bids for the award of a Contract for the construction of improvements in the District in strict accordance with the Plans and Specifications therefor entitled, "CIP Project No. C14-08, Pacheco Blvd. & Shell Oil Easement Sewer Rehabilitation" dated July 2008, prepared by the District Engineer LCC, Inc., and on file in the office of said District.

The work in general consists of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals as necessary to remove existing manholes and pipelines, abandon existing manholes and pipelines, install precast PVC lined manholes with epoxy coated bases, 24" PVC by open trench, and 18" HDPEP by pipebursting, and replacing manhole frame and covers together with such other items of work and details required by the District Specifications, the State Standard Specifications, and the Special Provisions and Plans prepared therefore. The Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$710,000.

Said sealed bids shall be delivered to the District Manager of the District on or before said date and time, at the District office, 3800 Arthur Road, Martinez, CA 94553. Any bids received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids shall be returned unopened. Bids will be publicly opened and examined on said day and hour by the District Manager or his authorized representative and will be referred to and considered by the Mt. View Sanitary District Board of Directors at their meeting to be held at 6:30 PM August 28, 2008 at its meeting place.

A recommended non-mandatory pre-bid meeting for bidders is scheduled for 10 AM, Wednesday, August 20, 2008 on Pacheco Blvd. opposite Wygal Drive. Individual visits to the site on the Shell property may be scheduled with the District upon request subject to the provisions in Section 2 of the Special Provisions.

Each bid shall be in accordance with said Plans, Specifications and other Contract Documents now on file in the office of the District. Copies may be obtained from the District Office for a non-refundable price of twenty dollars (\$20.00) or forty dollars (\$40.00) if mailed. Plans and specifications may be inspected at the District Office, 3800 Arthur Road, Martinez, CA 94553, telephone number (925) 228-5635. Within five working days after the bid opening date for this project, the three apparent lowest bidders shall submit a credit report, current within 30 days of the bid opening date for this project. For privacy purposes, the report may be submitted in the envelope marked "CONFIDENTIAL". To be considered a responsible bidder on this project, either the Contractor's credit report shall indicate a Dun & Bradstreet credit risk rating of 1A2 or better or the Contractor's bank shall issue a financial statement enclosed in bid packet.

Notice is hereby given that for any moneys earned by the Contractor and withheld by the District to ensure performance of the contract, the Contractor may, at his/her request and expense, substitute securities equivalent to the amount withheld in the form and manner and subject to the conditions provided in Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California.

All proposals or bids shall be presented under sealed cover and shall be accompanied by one of the following forms of bidders security: cash, a certified or cashier's check or a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, all made payable to the order of the Mt. View Sanitary District amounting to ten percent (10%) of the bid. The bidder's security shall be forfeited to said District in case the bidder depositing the same does not, within fifteen (15) days after written notice that the contract has been awarded to him/her, enter into a contract with the District, which contract shall be accompanied by a payment bond and a faithful performance bond, each in a sum equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount so bid, under the provisions of Sections 3247 through 3252, inclusive, of the Civil Code of the State of California.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that, pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code of the State of California, the District has obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work for each craft, classification, or type of worker required to execute the contract. A copy of said prevailing rate of per diem wages is on file in the office of the Secretary, to such reference is hereby made for further particulars. Said prevailing rate of per diem wages shall be made available to any interested party upon request, and a copy thereof shall be posted at the job site. Not less than said prevailing rate of per diem wages shall be paid for any work proposed to be performed.

The Contractor will be required to comply with all provisions of Section 1770 et seq. of the Labor Code of the State of California.

The award of contract shall only be made to a Contractor who possesses a Class A (California Contractor's) License, pursuant to Section 3300 of the Public Contract Code, or a combination of Class C Licenses which constitute a majority of the work.

The District Board may, at its discretion, reject any and all bids or waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for opening of bids.
