# ATTORNEY'S REPORT

**SUBJECT:** CASA Attorneys Committee Meeting

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I attended a *virtual* CASA Attorneys Committee Meeting on October 22, 2021.

Recently enacted legislation was a major topic of discussion and I have included the following: items of significance to the District

- AB 361 regarding Virtual Meetings. You adopted a resolution under this legislation as the first item of business this evening.
- SB 323 added a 120 day Statute of Limitations for a challenge of a Prop 218 rate increase. To take advantage of this new limitation, we must include it in our 218 Notice. I plan on adding it to our form for future 218 Notices.
- The Flushable wipes labeling bill became law. Unfortunately, it relies on private action for enforcement (i.e. no public agency is charged with enforcement obligations)
- Finally, PFAS regulation is not going away and it is anticipated that USEPA will publish standards in 2022 that may impact NPDES Permits.
